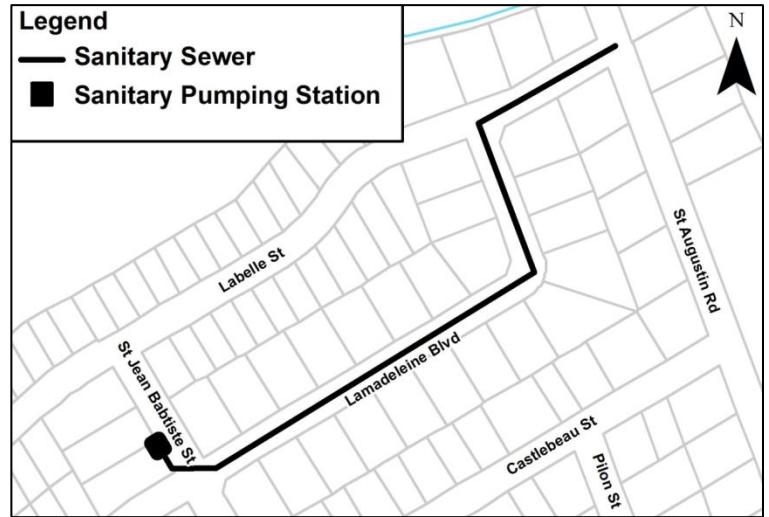




The Township of Russell is planning to construct a sanitary pumping station to service a new gravity sanitary sewer to be constructed on Lamadeleine Blvd. from St. Jean Baptiste Street to St. Augustin Road, as well as future development to the north of Labelle Street. The intent of the proposed design is to upgrade Lamadeleine Blvd. to municipal services.

This project is being completed in compliance with the planning and design process for Schedule 'B' undertaking as defined in the Municipal Engineers Association "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment" (October 2000, as amended 2007 & 2011).

The technically preferred alternative is to install a prefabricated sanitary pumping station within Omer Lamadeleine Park at the corner of Lamadeleine Blvd. and St. Jean Baptiste Street and install a gravity sanitary sewer on Lamadeleine Blvd. as depicted on the above figure. Future development to the north of Labelle Street will be serviced by a proposed gravity sewer from the development along Labelle Street to the proposed pumping station.



The Township of Russell will be hosting a Council Meeting at 6:00 p.m. on March 20th, 2017 at Town Hall, located at 717 Notre-Dame street, which will provide information pertaining to the proposed project, as well as allow interested parties to ask questions and provide comments.

Please provide written comments to the Township of Russell within 30 calendar days from the date of this notice. If concerns regarding this project cannot be resolved in discussion with the Township of Russell, a person may request that the Minister of the Environment and Climate Change make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as Part II Order), which addresses individual environmental assessments. Requests must be made to the Minister at the address below by **April 7, 2017**. A copy of the request must be forwarded to the Township of Russell. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice and the receipt of necessary approval and funding, the Township of Russell intends to proceed with detail design and construction of this project in 2017/2018.
